FOR FAMILIES

- New applications only: The online application should be used for new applications only. Families need to use paper forms for Redeterminations (REDE), Change of Information (COI), and Change of Provider (COP).
- Automatic submission: Completed applications & supporting documents are sent to the family's CCR&R or Site Provider for processing.

FOR PROVIDERS

- Provider ID number: Find your provider number! You'll need it to respond to applications. You can find this 8-15 digit number on approval notices or certificate reports from IDHS.
- Families will email/text: Families
 will email or text providers when
 listed on their application. Providers
 need to share up-to-date contact
 info with families before they apply.
- Provider response: Respond to a family's application by using the secure link or confirmation code sent by the the family.
- Respond in 3 days: Respond to an application within 3 business days.
 This should take 5 minutes or less.
